Selection Criteria:

- 1. Graduating high school student who has participated in 4-H four (4) out of the last six (6) years in the Estill County 4-H Program.
- 2. ACT and / or SAT scores which predict achievement at the college level.
- 3. Academic excellence in the classroom.
- 4. Extracurricular activities, especially in the area of 4-H.
- 5. Application to an accredited, 2 or 4 year institution of higher education which grants degrees, with credit hours of a minimum of 12 hours / semester.
- 6. <u>Currently enrolled in 4-H members who have participated in 4-H four (4) out of the last six (6) years.</u>
- 7. The Scholarship Committee will review the applications and make recommendations to the 4-H Council, which will vote and make the final decision.
- 8. Application winner will be advised in writing.
- 9. Scholarship will be paid to the recipient in the form of a check, payable upon presentation of a college schedule. There will be no restrictions as to what the money has to be spent for.
- 10. The amount of the scholarship will be \$500. Scholarship will be awarded in the amount of ½ per semester. Second ½ of scholarship will be given upon receiving a copy of the college schedule for the spring semester and a grade transcript for the fall semester.
- 11. Applications will be available in Spring semester of graduation year, and must be turned in complete by deadline set by local high school guidance office. NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted.
