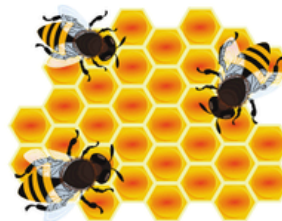


FIRST MEETING: MAY 27 AT 6:00 PM
